To continue our discussion of the five principal design elements of the new Aspen Art Museum, this week I would like to feature a look at the “moving room,” a.k.a. the glass reception elevator.

This innovative, transparent elevator, roughly 8 by 12 feet in area, will animate the northeast corner of the new AAM where South Spring Street and Hyman Avenue meet. Similar to the grand staircase previously discussed, the elevator will blend exterior and interior spaces, utilizing the effects of natural light and creating an integrated yet singular space of relaxed travel between building spaces and galleries.

Beyond the wonderful experience of being able to be whisked from the first-floor lobby to the floor of one’s choosing, our “moving room” will also assure that we are a completely state-of-the-art, ADA-compliant facility.
